Everyone has their list of favourite sires and we are no exception, one of ours is Heza Fast Man a stallion not all that familiar in Australia he is the sire of our mare Shez Nobodys Darling.

Heza Fast Man stood at JEH Stallion Station for all his stud life, he was euthanized

December 6<sup>th</sup> 2005 following a long battle with Laminitis and was 14 yrs old. Heza Fast man was raced by San Tan Tillage Inc and was a winner of 10 races from 17 life time starts and

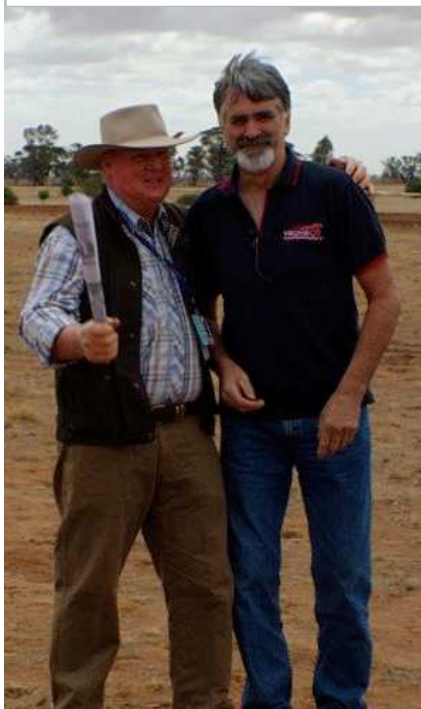

The Jockeys are a major part of racing as a whole and sprint racing is no different, some of the stars of the current season have been Lenny Andrews, David Johnson, Mike Preston, Kody Eldred and Lorene Inmon. Their performances at Birchip were as you would expect from class athletes, when I asked Mike Preston who would win the Cup it wasn't overconfidence when he said Buzraami will win, as if to say well it was up to me if I wanted to back it. On the day a visiting jockey was enticed to ride when a vacancy became available, and what a great job she did and we talk of Gretel Wilson. We look forward to her joining the sprint racing ranks.

### The Stars of The Show



accumulated the earnings of \$801,356, had a speed index of 111.

He was a star at 2, trained by John Bassett Heza Fast Man set two new track records in Arizona. He went 300 yards in 15.86 in the trials to the Kevin Burns Memorial Futurity and returned in the finals to break his own record in 15.85. Won the Texas Classic Futurity G1 and finishing second by a nose in the All American Futurity G1, at 3 his form continued winning the Vandys Flash Handicap G3 and running second in the All American derby G1. Heza Fast Man last raced in December 1994 and was retired to stud at JEH stallion Station when it was located at the old Phillips Ranch in Frisco, Texas where he has been a leading sire with winners in excess of \$12 million. He has had 547 starters with 369 winners of those 51 have been stakes winners, 2 have won world championships, 1 world champion, 14 regional championships and 12 region champions. Heza Fast Man himself was AQHA Racing Champion three year old colt.

Fitness Lady (dam by On A High) 251,680

Value The Man (dam by Dashing Val) \$681,6836

And the list goes on.

From an Australian perspective it is interesting to note that Heza Fast Mans sire The Signature is by Noholme an Australian bred son of the speed line Star Kingdom and a brother to Todman a Golden Slipper Winner. We have such terrific speed line horses in Australia to mate with the American sprinter and if our Industry moves forward some of these matings will provide some exciting speed.

The current statistics as of March 6<sup>th</sup> 2009 have Heza Fast Man for the current racing season 24 starters 4 winners sitting no.25 on money earned and in 14<sup>th</sup> spot for winners sired a remarkable achievement, given the number of sires and how quickly they lose favour.

As a sire he excelled with winners totaling in excess of \$11 Million.

He has been a great broodmare sire with 29 + Stakes Winners. He died in 2002 at Vessels Stallion Station of Laminitis.
